




# Rob And Kim's Guest Getaway Guide




## Fox N Hare Brewing Co.

## Grey Towers National Historic

Grey Towers was the home of Gifford Pinchot, first Chief of the US Forest Service and Pennsylvania Governor. The property is magnificent and a must see. ## Stairway Lake

A 3+ mile hike will lead you to our little hidden treasure...Stairway Lake. A beautiful lake with views of the Delaware and fishing. The parking area to begin your hike is less than a mile from the cottage.



## Raymondskill Falls

Less than a 30 minute drive, you will find the three-tiered Raymondskill Falls, which is the tallest waterfall in Pennsylvania. If you add the drops from each tier together, the waterfall is only a few feet shorter than Niagara Falls.



## High Point State Park

The view from High Point Monument, at 1,803 feet above sea level, is a spectacular panorama of rich farmland and forest, soft hills and lush valleys in three states. The blue line of the Delaware River divides the verdant ridges of New Jersey from those of Pennsylvania. High Point offers superb trails for hikers and skiers and quiet spots for campers and anglers.



## The Columns Museum of the Pike County Historical Society

608 Broad Street

The Columns is a local history museum housed in a 1904 neo-classical mansion on Broad Street in Milford, Pa. The building also serves as the location of the Pike County Historical Society, official historical society of the county.

The museum houses the famed Lincoln Flag, which is the flag placed under President Abraham Lincoln's head the night he was shot at Ford's Theater. The flag is stained with the President's blood. Other items include a 1850's Stagecoach, and articles pertaining to the people, places and events that have made up Pike County's rich history.



## Tri States Monument


Visit the Tristate monument, stand on it and you will be able to tell your friends that you were standing in three states at one time. This historic landmark is located in New York, New Jersey & Pennsylvania.



## Hawks Nest

Whether you go by motorcycle or by car, the Hawk's Nest is a must see. 


## Bethel Woods Center for the Arts


## Milford
